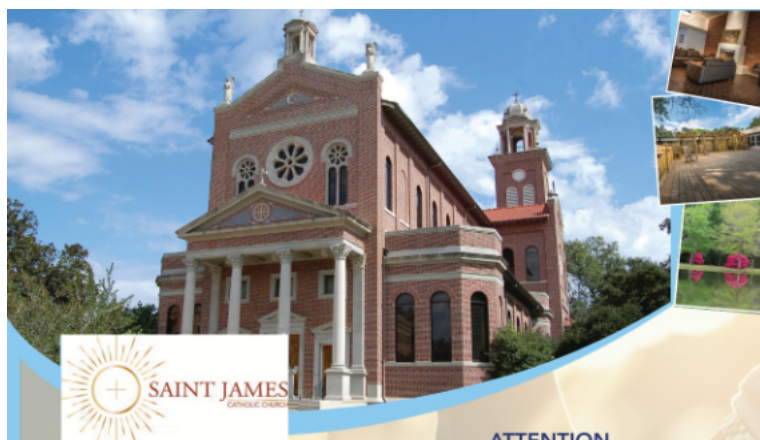
Clearing the Confusion: Common Misconceptions About Annulments

Many Catholics have questions regarding annulments. Here's the truth:

Myth: I can't receive Communion (or I'm unwelcome at Mass) because I'm divorced and don't have an annulment.

Truth: Divorce itself does not change a person's standing in the Catholic Church, and it does not mean you are unwelcome at Mass. Sadly, this misconception has caused many people unnecessary fear or shame. Divorced Catholics are encouraged to continue participating in the life of the Church, including attending Mass and staying connected to the parish community. However, if a person has remarried without a declaration of nullity, they should refrain from receiving the Eucharist until their situation is resolved—but they should still come to Mass and remain close to the Lord and His Church.
