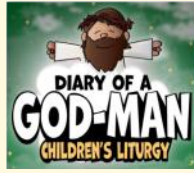

PENTECOST

The liturgical season of Easter concludes with the celebration of Pentecost. During Easter, our church has been decorated in white, which symbolizes purity, light, glory and joy; however, on the 50th and final day of Easter, the church is ablaze with the color of red on the Feast of Pentecost. Red symbolizes the tongues of fire that descended upon the Blessed Mother, the Apostles and other disciples who were in the Upper Room following Jesus' Ascension to Heaven. Those tongues of fire were the Holy Spirit promised by Jesus to give them the fortitude they would need to spread the Gospel. They were given the spiritual help to boldly proclaim Jesus as Lord. That feast of Pentecost was the birthday of the Church.

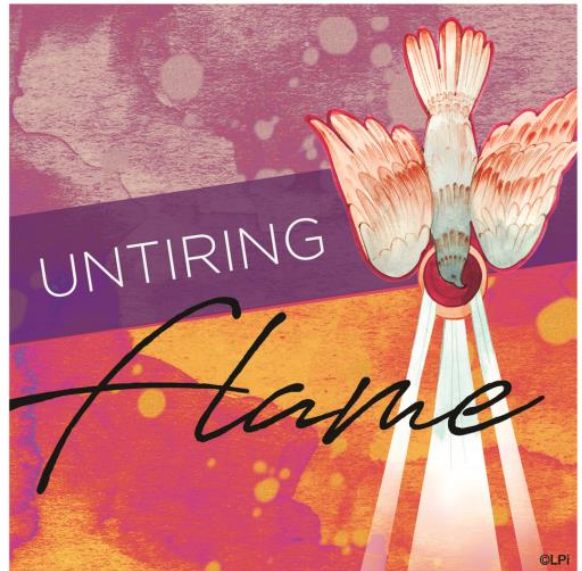

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

When I was twenty-two years of age in August of 2000, I experienced World Youth Day in Rome. As for many of my generation, the event was life-changing for me. Surrounded by joyful, hope-filled young people from seemingly every nation and tongue, we were gathered around the Pope, sharing a common Faith and love. The Pope spoke to us of our shared family bond in the Church and invited us to give our lives in service to others. Now twenty-four years later, my life as a priest, like that of so many others from those special days, continues on that same path of love and unity — despite my many weaknesses. What makes that continuation possible?

This week's feast gives the answer: the Holy Spirit. The gift of God — His very life — the third person of the Trinity, is the Spirit who animates the entire Church and each member of it. He makes us one-in-love in a way that utterly exceeds human capacity. For example, he makes the apostles speak with tongues of fire, and everyone hears them in his own native tongue. The Holy Spirit is the means by which Jesus establishes a new family, one that crosses all possible boundaries of time, space, and culture. The Holy Spirit never tires in enthusing us for mission.

Aren't we longing to experience the Holy Spirit in a fresh way? Today we celebrate this untiring flame, once ignited on earth and burning still. So, we humbly cry out: Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and enkindle in us the fire of your love!

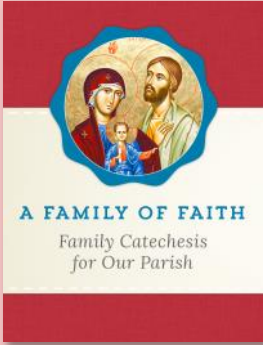

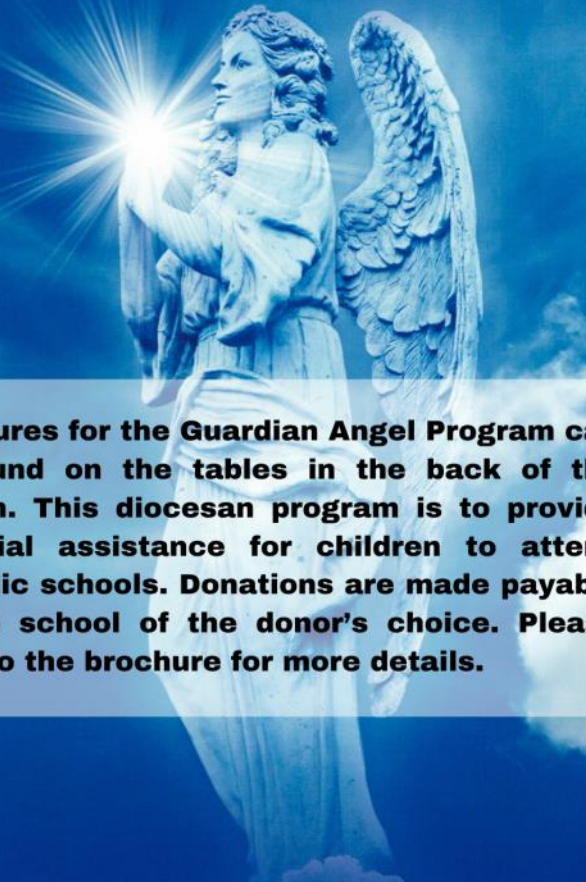

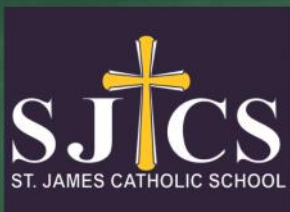

Eucharistic Miracle of GRUARO (VALVASONE)

Among the most authoritative documents which describe the Eucharistic miracle which took place at Gruaro in 1294 is that of local historian Antonio Nicoletti (1765). A woman was washing one of the altar linens of the Church of St. Giusto in the public wash-house of Verisolo. Suddenly she saw the altar linen become tinged with Blood. Observing more closely, she noted that the blood was flowing from a consecrated Particle remaining among the folds of the cloth.



The site of the Miracle is kept in the Church of the Most Holy Body of Christ in Valvasone. For the miracle happened in Gruaro, in 1294, a young boy named Vito was the public wash-house of Verisolo to wash the altar linen of the Church of St. Giusto in Gruaro. Suddenly, the woman noticed that a consecrated Host had remained on the table among the folds of the cloth and the blood was flowing from it. Inspired by this remarkable event, she immediately ran to show the pastor who then referred the Bishop of Concordia, Giacomo di Chiovaro, from Concordia. The Bishop having learned the facts, asked to be able to keep the site of the miracle in his Cathedral in Concordia. However, the pastor of Gruaro and the Bishop of the Diocese of Udine, present at the church of Gruaro and of Valvasone, wanted

to keep the site. No agreement was reached, and so it was decided to ask, in common with the Holy See for the said, some for the Church keep the site, on the condition that they would build a church dedicated to the Most Holy Body of Christ. The construction of the church was completed in 1485.

The oldest and most authoritative documents describing the miracle is a decree of Pope Nicholas V written in 1484. The site of the parish church, formerly St. Mary and St. John the Evangelist was thereby changed to the Church of the Most Holy Body of Christ March 26, 1485. Today the church is kept in a special celebration held by a processional reliquary of silver made by master craftsmen Antonio Calligaris. The reliquary of the Holy Christ is
