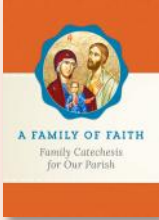

The St. Vincent de Paul Society logo is used in many countries and is recognized everywhere as a symbol of hope and goodwill. The logo has three components: the hands, the text, and the slogan. The top hand is the **Hand of Christ** blessing the cup. The middle hand is the **Hand of Love** which offers the cup, and the bottom hand is the **Hand of Suffering** which receives the cup.

This symbol of the hands truly reflects the work of the members, volunteers, and employees of the Society. The Hand of Giving shows our good works, the Hand of Suffering shows those we serve, and the Hand of Christ present, above all others, acknowledges His strong presence in the relationship between ourselves and those we help through the Holy Spirit.

We take this opportunity to give thanks to our generous parishioners, ministries, school, parents and children for all their support throughout the year. Over the past fiscal year, beginning OCTOBER 1, 2024 through SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, we have tried to be good stewards of your acts of charity. Your donations have helped us to provide the following assistance:

Utilities - 215 households (719 people) totaling \$35,854.66 in financial aid

Food - 523 households (1080 people) Food for pantry \$8358

Twinning (funds to other conferences) - \$4,913

Disaster Relief (Hurricane Helene) \$2500 St Margaret Mary SVDP and Texas Flood \$500

In addition, we have also assisted with porch repair, installation and purchase of air conditioners, and installation of a hot water heater (donated); we partnered with Saint J Youth in providing 20 Rouses gift cards for the Bountiful Thanksgiving bags; and we also assisted with 10 Rouses Christmas gift cards, prescriptions, bedding, hygiene bags and miscellaneous clothing (men's shirts, socks, blankets, gloves, hats, scarves, etc.). Hats were handmade by one of our St Vincent de Paul "Vinnies".

Our St. Vincent de Paul office is open on Tuesdays from 9:00AM until 11:45AM and on Thursdays from 10:00AM until 11:30AM. Items can be dropped off anytime at the Parish Office, or put in the back of the church in our St. Vincent de Paul boxes.

Envelopes are available on the tables at the back of the church for your donations. Please make your checks payable to St. James St. Vincent de Paul Society.

Again, thank you for your continued support - it allows our ministry to weekly assist those in need of the works of Mercy.

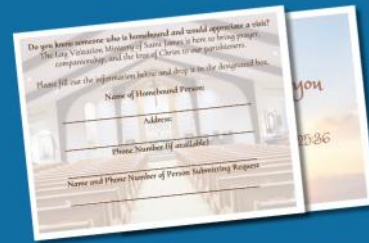

Clearing the Confusion: Common Misconceptions About Annulments

Many Catholics have questions regarding annulments. Here's the truth:

Myth: Only marriages that took place in the Catholic Church need an annulment before remarriage.

➔ **Truth: The Church recognizes all marriages, Catholic or not, as valid unless proven otherwise. This means that anyone who was previously married is not free to enter a new marriage in the Church until a declaration of nullity has been obtained. In some cases, the process is straightforward and mostly administrative, but it is still necessary before a new marriage can be celebrated.**

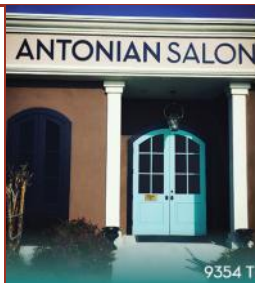

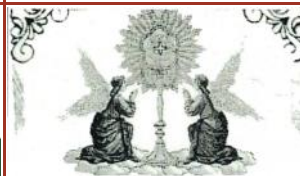
