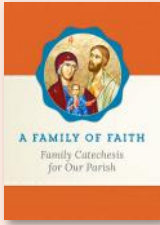

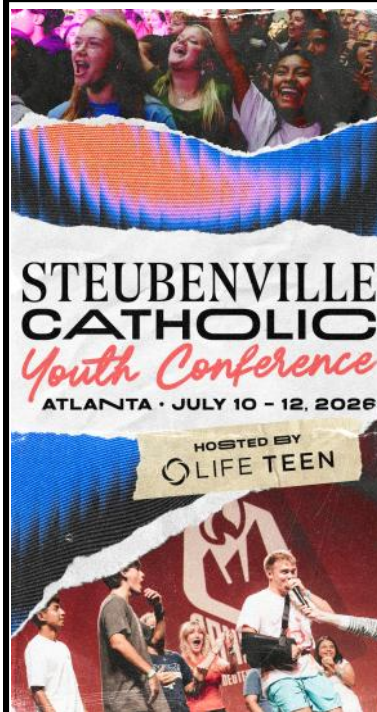

Clearing the Confusion: Common Misconceptions About Annulments

Many Catholics have questions regarding annulments.

Here's the truth:

What exactly is an "annulment"?

➔ Actually, nothing is "made" null in this process. Formally known as a "declaration of nullity," an "annulment" is a ruling from the Church tribunal of a diocese (a tribunal is a Catholic Church court) that a particular marriage was invalid (or "null") from the beginning.
