Candlemas on February 2

If you count 40 days after the celebration of Christmas you reach February 2. Early on, the Church marked that day with a special feast and it is the final "baby Jesus" day in the liturgical calendar before the celebration of Lent. The feast has many different names in the Roman Catholic Church. It has been called the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary and, more familiarly, Candlemas.

Though not a holy day of obligation, it is a beautiful day in the Church's calendar. It signals the end of the "Christmas-Cycle" and looks forward to the light that will shatter all darkness at the Easter Vigil — when another candlelight service is performed in recognition that, "the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light, on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death light has arisen" (Matthew 4:16).

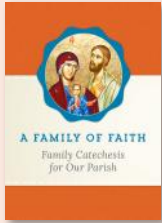

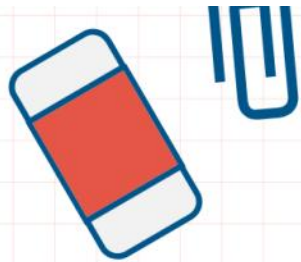

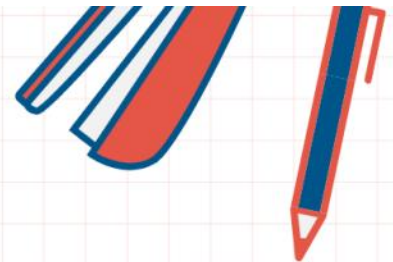

CATHOLIC SCHOOL SUBSIDY

To obtain the Catholic rate at St. James Catholic School and/or St. Patrick Catholic High School, one must be a registered and participating family who regularly contributes to Saint James Parish (using checks, parish envelopes or electronic giving). Each school year, parents must bring a subsidy form from the school to the parish office for the pastor to sign in order to receive the subsidized tuition rate.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Parents are responsible before God to choose appropriate schooling for each of their children. Our task, as a parish community, is to assist parents as best we can with the tools they need to raise their children as good Catholics. Each year, our parish is assessed a certain percentage of our Sunday collection to be allocated to our local Catholic schools, St. James Catholic School and St. Patrick Catholic High School. As such, Saint James Parish has money set aside in the 2026/2027 budget for our registered contributing families to help with Catholic elementary and high school tuition costs.

At Saint James, our policy is also to set aside a proportional amount to support our faith formation programs for parents who choose public schools or home schooling for their children.

We follow a "needs based" policy. Both schools utilize FACTS, an organization that specializes in determining the financial need of each family. The Tuition Assistance application process is now open. There is a processing fee.

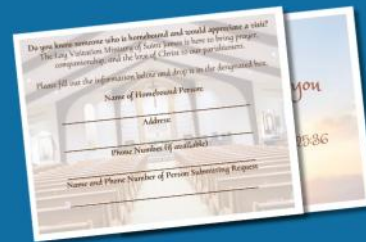

Clearing the Confusion: Common Misconceptions About Annulments

Many Catholics have questions regarding annulments. Here's the truth:

Myth: I can't receive Communion (or I'm unwelcome at Mass) because I'm divorced and don't have an annulment.

➔ **Truth: Divorce itself does not change a person's standing in the Catholic Church, and it does not mean you are unwelcome at Mass. Sadly, this misconception has caused many people unnecessary fear or shame. Divorced Catholics are encouraged to continue participating in the life of the Church, including attending Mass and staying connected to the parish community. However, if a person has remarried without a declaration of nullity, they should refrain from receiving the Eucharist until their situation is resolved—but they should still come to Mass and remain close to the Lord and His Church.**

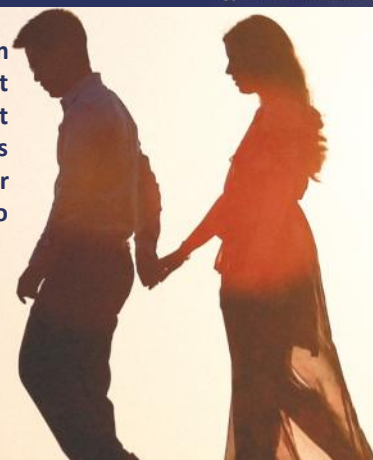

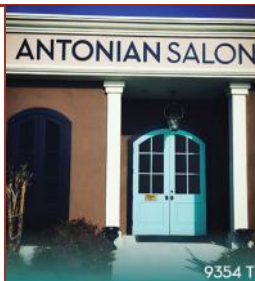
