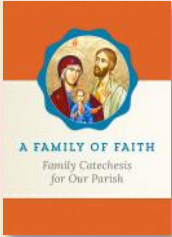

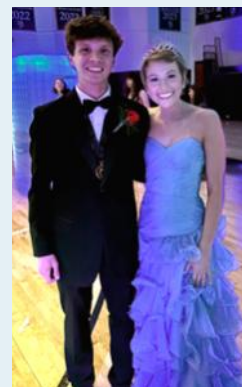

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today I am announcing a special *Called by Name* Campaign to identify faithful young men and women in our diocese who may have a vocation to the priesthood or religious life. The campaign will take place on October 4-5, 2025.

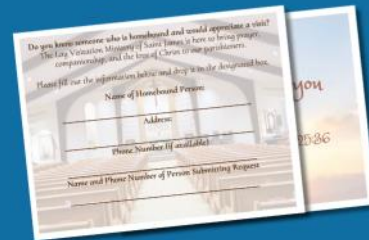
