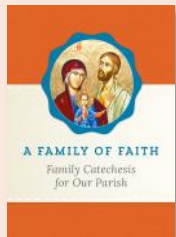

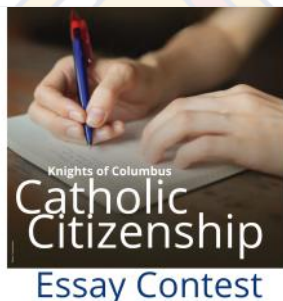

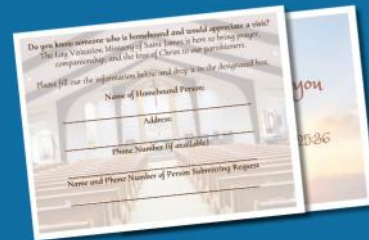

Clearing the Confusion: Common Misconceptions About Annulments

Many Catholics have questions regarding annulments.

Here's the truth:

I can't get an annulment because we have children together and/or were married too long.

➔ Any divorced person has the right to request a declaration of nullity ("annulment"). The duration of the marriage or whether there were children born of the marriage is not a decisive factor. While it is true that in some cases the brevity of a marriage supports other evidence that a marriage was invalid, a long marriage does not mean the marriage was valid.

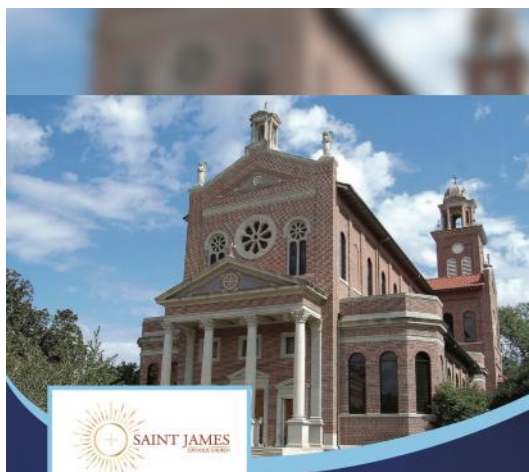

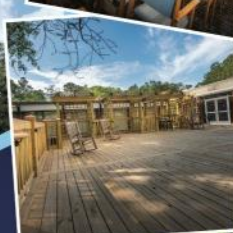
