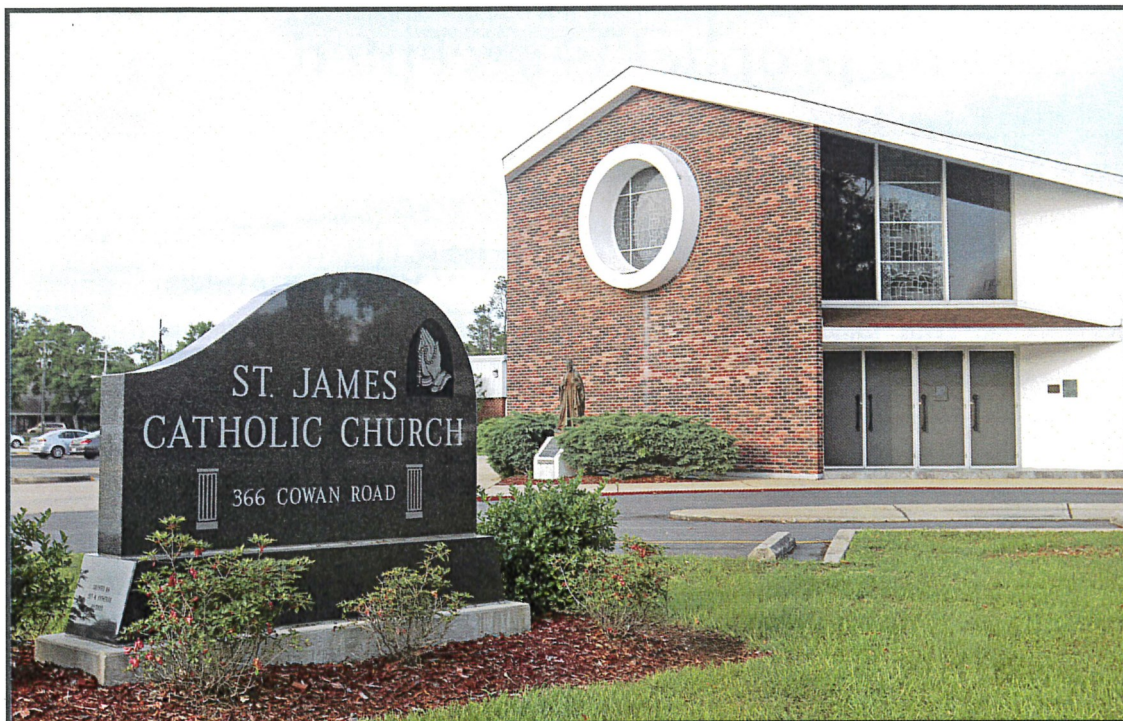

GOD'S ONGOING WORK

In today's Gospel Luke, the author of Acts, links the "time of Pentecost" to the Jewish Feast of Weeks. This was a harvest festival, fifty days after Passover. The feast became a celebration of God's gift of the Torah, the law of Moses, remembering Exodus 19. Luke suggests that just as the Feast of Weeks was a culmination of Passover, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit was a culmination of the Resurrection. In both Passover and Easter, God's extraordinary saving action rescued God's people from oppression and death. Because of these actions, the stage was set for the gift of Torah, and similarly for Christians, the gift of the Spirit. The ongoing presence of the Spirit sustains us to face life's burdens gracefully. The Spirit also challenges us daily to mature in our capacity to love, and to take part in God's ongoing work to rescue all God's people.

WHAT GOD IS UP TO

The Christian community gathered in the Upper Room, awaiting the Holy Spirit, has long stirred the Christian imagination. In our own time, when the Church has a long history of Christian faith but now faces many challenges, we might return to this image. Like the first disciples, we often don't know what to do next. What used to work for us doesn't work as well. We need to stay together, honor diversity, reflect upon the roots of our faith, and remain rooted in prayer.

Yet there is more. Pentecost has happened and is happening. The Spirit has already burst out into the world, already stirring among those who are confused about God. The Book of Acts tells the story of a Church continually pushed out by the Spirit, to join in what God was already up to, out in the world. We too are invited not only to remember our unity and our roots, but to pay acute attention to how the Spirit is working in our local communities.

VARIETY OF GIFTS

In today's second reading, Saint Paul wrote to the Church in Corinth, a community encountering tensions and divisions over spiritual gifts. Paul reminds them that the Spirit shares a variety of gifts; none is better than any other, and all are needed by the whole Church. The Spirit is revealed in the diversity of gifts offered by individuals and by distinct groups. The Spirit desires that the Church live as an interdependent, cohesive whole, as the Body of Christ.

A parish can be a collegial partnership where parishioners, clergy, and ministry staff can confidently share God's gifts. Gifts from persons and groups of diverse backgrounds can be honored. Gifts that tend to be less visible, such as in finance, custodial work, or administration, can be celebrated as much as those in preaching and music. May we notice God's grace in this diversity.

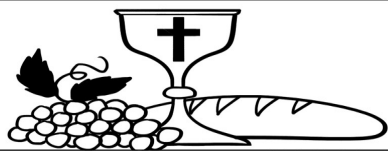

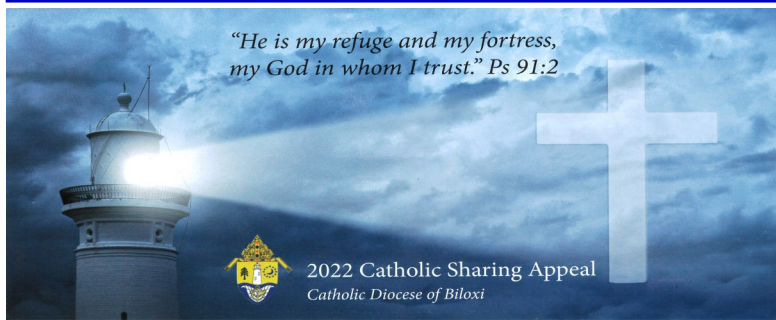

ARE YOU REGISTERED AT SAINT JAMES?

IMPORTANT — PLEASE READ!

If you attend Mass here on a regular basis and in order for our parish to better assist you in times of sacramental needs, such as baptism or marriage, and in times of illness or death, you need to be officially registered. Registration forms are on the tables at the back of the church, or you may call our office and we will mail one to you. Completed forms may be dropped in the regular collection.

SUBSIDY /TUITION ASSISTANCE POLICY:

ST. JAMES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL/ST. PATRICK HIGH SCHOOL
Grades K-12 in order for students to receive subsidized tuition and or tuition assistance:

EACH SCHOOL YEAR parents must bring a subsidy form from St. James/St. Patrick to the parish office for the pastor to sign, in order to receive the subsidized rate. The following requirements apply:

- 1) The family must be **registered with the parish a minimum of six months.**
*Unless your family has just moved to this area, and when registering you filled out an ACH form for church contributions.
- 2) For Pre-K-6th grade, at St. James School you must turn in a **Catholic Baptismal certificate** to the school and the parents must donate 2 hours, 2 times a year in service to the St. James Elementary School.
- 3) The family must contribute **identifiably** to the support of the parish through the regular weekly or monthly use of the envelope system, by automatic draft/ electronic fund transfer, your personal check to identify you or cash in an envelope with your name on it.
- 4) The family **must attend** weekend Mass with the parish family at St. James.
- 5) If you are an active supporting Catholic family from another parish, you may be eligible to receive subsidy through that parish. Contact the school principal for further information.

JUNE Month of the Sacred Heart

DEVOTION OF THE MONTH

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Although it was beloved in previous centuries, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: "My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition." She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it "the great act" of his pontificate.

300 tags must be pre-sold before the Department of Revenue will begin production on a particular distinctive tag. When the Department of Revenue receives the 300 applications, the appropriate fees, and a Department-approved design provided by the organization, the tag is sent for manufacturing. Applicants may pick up their tags from their county tax collector's office once the Organization has been notified the tags are ready. The tax collector's offices will have a list provided by the Department of the people who have already paid their fees and are entitled to one of the first 300 tags. The applicant should pick up his tag as soon he is notified that the tag is available at the tax collector's office. There is 60 days allowed from the time the organization is notified by the Department for the vehicle owner to pick up the license plate. If the applicant waits beyond the 60 day period to pick up his tag, the special tag fee must be paid again at the time the special tag is picked up.

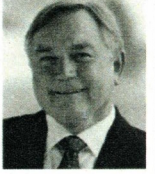

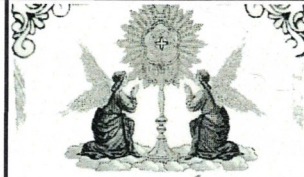

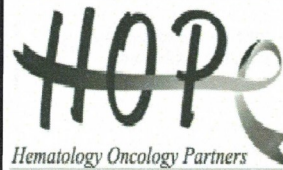
