



**Clearing the Confusion: Common Misconceptions About Annulments**

Many Catholics have questions regarding annulments. Here's the truth:

**Myth: Only Catholic marriages need to be annulled.**

➔ **Truth: Every marriage is presumed to be a lifelong commitment—until death—regardless of whether it was celebrated in a Catholic ceremony or not. For this reason, no one is considered free to enter a new marriage if they have been married previously. Any prior marriage must be examined by the Church before a person may marry again. It is a myth that an annulment is unnecessary simply because a previous marriage was not Catholic.**


