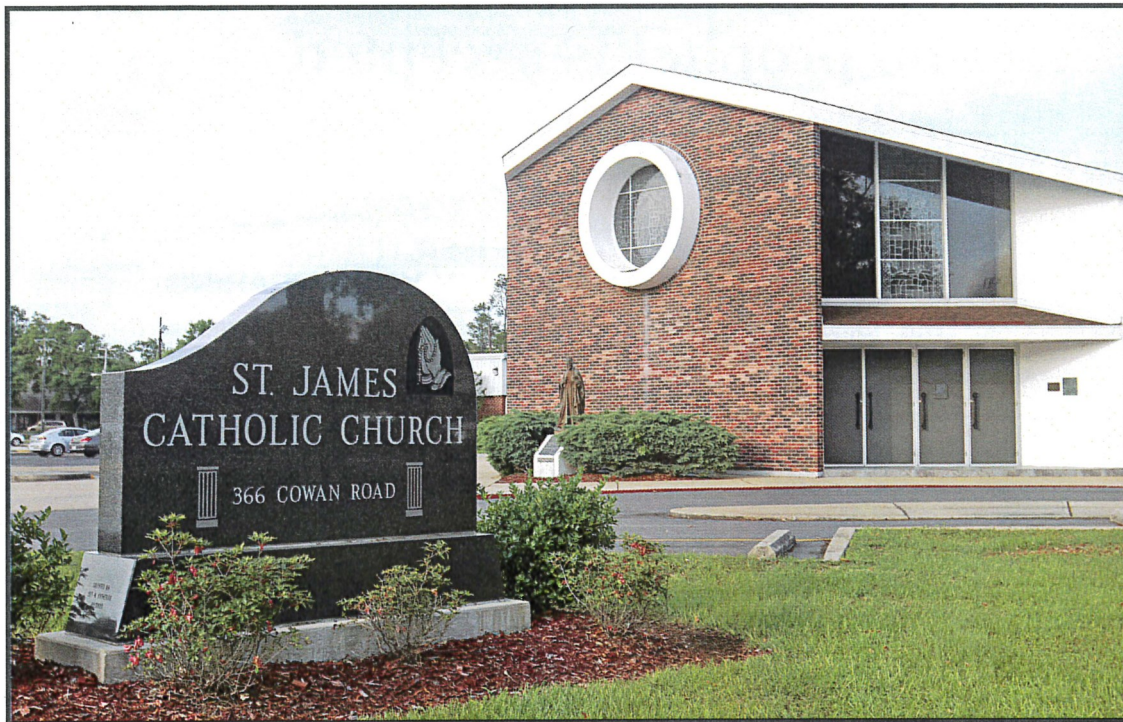

## CHURCH

The Easter season provides us an opportunity to reflect upon who we are as Church, in light of the first experiences of Jesus' followers. From today's Gospel, we realize that all we do is founded on our friendship with and trust in Jesus, as witnessed in Jesus' dialogue with Peter. From Revelation, in the image of Jesus as the sacrificial Lamb, we can anticipate suffering for the sake of love for God and for others. From the apostles' bold speech in Acts, we remember that when we stay true to the Gospel, even at great cost, we must always embody God's forgiveness toward those who resist God's invitation. The early Church struggled to understand how to live the way of Jesus, and we can expect no less struggle for ourselves. And like them, we may also know the joy of growing friendship with God along the way.

## OBEYING GOD

In the first chapters of Acts, the apostles venture out energetically, soon after Pentecost, to proclaim the risen Jesus. Today's reading shows the Sanhedrin, the formal religious body that had condemned Jesus shortly before, now threatening the apostles. The Sanhedrin likely feared that Jesus' followers would, in vengeance for the Crucifixion, stir up a riot or even a violent revolt. The apostles, consistent with Jesus' own dealings with the authorities, proclaim Jesus' message of God's forgiveness of everyone, and refuse to incite violence.

It is a great challenge, as Peter said, to "obey God rather than man." Throughout history, when groups of God's people, inspired by God's dream for a just and free world, have spoken out non-violently against injustice and oppression, they have sought to obey God's summons. We the Church, while always mindful of the dangers of self-deception, are similarly called to discern and obey God in our own time and place.

## REPEATED QUESTIONS

In today's Gospel, John sets the scene for Jesus' encounter with Peter, sitting by a "charcoal fire." There is just one other mention of a charcoal fire in John's Gospel: when Peter warms himself while awaiting Jesus' trial, and Peter goes on to deny knowing Jesus, three times. The evangelist directly links Jesus' three questions of Peter, "do you love me?", to Peter's three denials. Through his repeated questioning, Jesus helps Peter to face his actions fully, and to accept forgiveness fully as well.

When God invites us into prayer, we may be invited to enter into deep conversation with God about our lives. God can pose the same questions to us, again and again over time, to face what we might prefer to avoid: Can you forgive someone who has hurt you? Can you be more generous? Can you let go of obstacles to becoming more loving? And even: Do you love me? Jesus' encounter with Peter suggests that we can face such questions with deep trust in God.

## ARE YOU REGISTERED AT SAINT JAMES?

**IMPORTANT — PLEASE READ!**

If you attend Mass here on a regular basis and in order for our parish to better assist you in times of sacramental needs, such as baptism or marriage, and in times of illness or death, you need to be officially registered. Registration forms are on the tables at the back of the church, or you may call our office and we will mail one to you. Completed forms may be dropped in the regular collection.

## SUBSIDY /TUITION ASSISTANCE POLICY:

**ST. JAMES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL/ST. PATRICK HIGH SCHOOL**  
**Grades K-12** in order for students to receive subsidized tuition and or tuition assistance:

**EACH SCHOOL YEAR parents must bring a subsidy form from St. James/St. Patrick to the parish office for the pastor to sign, in order to receive the subsidized rate. The following requirements apply:**

- 1) The family must be **registered with the parish a minimum of six months.**  
\*Unless your family has just moved to this area, and when registering you filled out an ACH form for church contributions.
- 2) For Pre-K-6th grade, at St. James School you must turn in a **Catholic Baptismal certificate** to the school and the parents must donate 2 hours, 2 times a year in service to the St. James Elementary School.
- 3) The family must contribute **identifiably** to the support of the parish through the regular weekly or monthly use of the envelope system, by automatic draft/electronic fund transfer, your personal check to identify you or cash in an envelope with your name on it.
- 4) The family **must attend** weekend Mass with the parish family at St. James.
- 5) If you are an active supporting Catholic family from another parish, you may be eligible to receive subsidy through that parish. Contact the school principal for further information.

## CATHOLIC SCHOOL SUBSIDY

To obtain the Catholic rate at St. James Catholic School and/or St. Patrick Catholic High School, one must be a registered and participating family who regularly contributes to Saint James Parish (using checks, parish envelopes or electronic giving). Each school year, parents must bring a subsidy form from the school to the parish office for the pastor to sign in order to receive the subsidized rate.

## TUITION ASSISTANCE

Parents are responsible before God to choose appropriate schooling for each of their children. Our task, as a parish community, is to assist parents as best we can with the tools, they need to raise their children as good Catholics. Each year our parish is assessed a certain percentage of our Sunday collection to be allocated to our local Catholic schools, St. James Catholic School and St. Patrick Catholic High School. As such, Saint James Parish has money set aside in the 2022/2023 budget for our registered contributing families to help with Catholic elementary and high school tuition costs. At Saint James, our policy is also to set aside a proportional amount to support our faith formation programs for parents who choose public schools or home schooling for their children.

**We follow a "needs based" tuition assistance policy. Both schools utilize organizations that specialize in determining the financial need of each family. The Tuition Assistance application process is now open.**

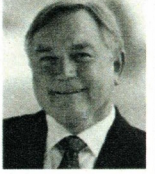

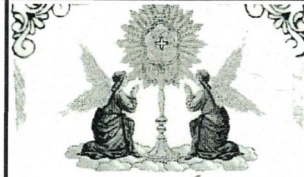

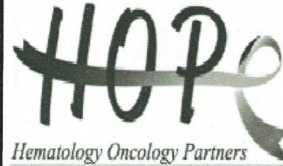
