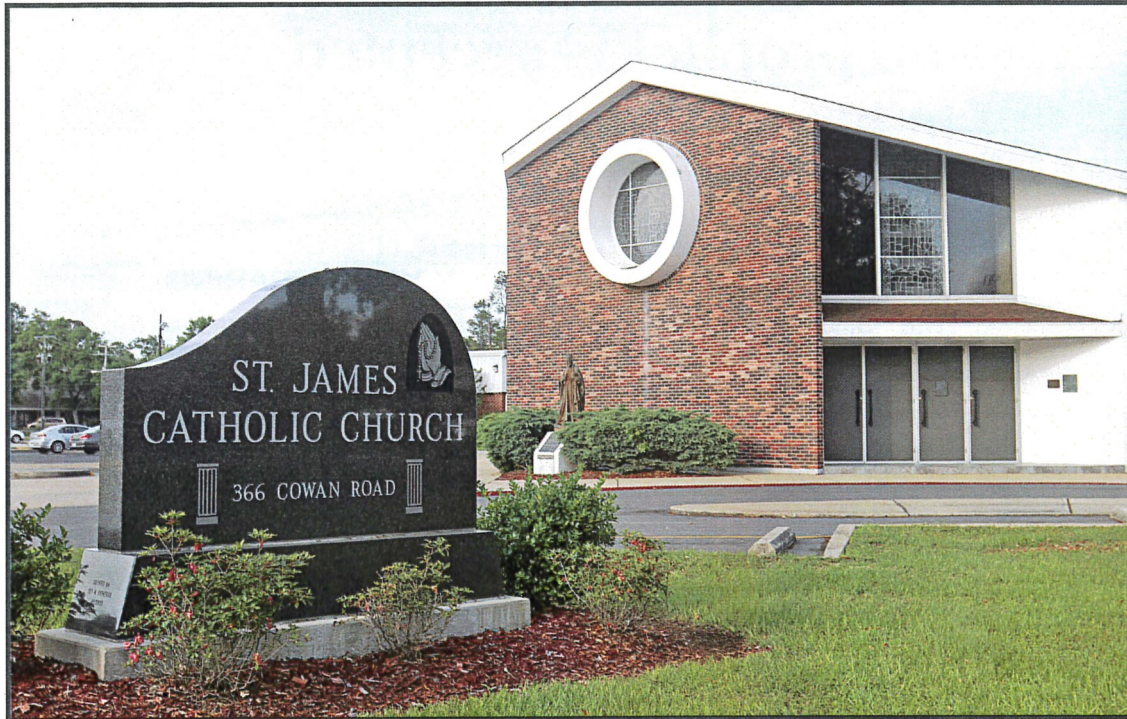

## THE LORD HAS DONE GREAT THINGS FOR US

Isaiah prophesies for the Lord: “Remember not the events of the past, the things of long ago consider not; see, I am doing something new!” One of the most dangerous things that we can do is get stuck in our old ways. As individuals, as parishes, as nations we can say, “We’ve always done it that way,” and miss calls to growth and change. Throughout this Lent and our lives, God continues to call us to life, and we should celebrate that! The psalmist reminds us that “The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy!” Saint Paul realizes this as he explains, “I continue my pursuit toward the goal, the prize of God’s upward calling, in Christ Jesus.” In the Gospel, Jesus offers a new way of looking at a tricky situation and provides a kinder, less judgmental response.

## AN AGE-OLD STORY OF JUDGEMENT

In our Gospel today we hear an ancient story, but one that feels like it could be taken out of the headlines today. We can be very quick to pass judgment on others, those with different political or cultural backgrounds, or perhaps with a different sexual orientation. Jesus was teaching in the temple, and the scribes and Pharisees did not like the message that he was proclaiming or the popularity he was gaining. When a nearby woman was caught in adultery, they thought it was the perfect chance to trip Jesus up, wondering how he would respond when the Mosaic Law provided clear consequences for such behavior. Many would be able to quote instantly chapter and verse of the law pertaining to the infraction. Instead of answering their question, Jesus turned it back on the accusers: “Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her.”

## DRAWING IN THE SAND

Awaiting the response of those challenging him, Jesus bent over and wrote in the sand. According to scripture scholar John Pilch, this was a simple technique that peasants used to buy time in a discussion or argument. Instead of looking the scribes and pharisees in the eye, he looked down and did his own thing while they all slipped away. The scriptures do not tell us what the woman was doing during this time. But by not looking at her, Jesus gave her a chance to restore her own dignity. He didn’t comment on her innocence or guilt. Rather, he instructed her to go forth and sin no more. It is not our past that matters as much as the choices we make now and in the future. Again and again, God gives us the chance to start our life over. This is our challenge this Lent, to continue to use the opportunities we are given to repent and grow.

## ARE YOU REGISTERED AT SAINT JAMES?

### IMPORTANT — PLEASE READ!

If you attend Mass here on a regular basis and in order for our parish to better assist you in times of sacramental needs, such as baptism or marriage, and in times of illness or death, you need to be officially registered. Registration forms are on the tables at the back of the church, or you may call our office and we will mail one to you. Completed forms may be dropped in the regular collection.

## SUBSIDY /TUITION ASSISTANCE POLICY:

**ST. JAMES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL/ST. PATRICK HIGH SCHOOL** Grades K-12 in order for students to receive subsidized tuition and or tuition assistance:

**EACH SCHOOL YEAR parents must bring a subsidy form from St. James/St. Patrick to the parish office for the pastor to sign, in order to receive the subsidized rate. The following requirements apply:**

- 1) The family must be **registered with the parish a minimum of six months.**  
\*Unless your family has just moved to this area, and when registering you filled out an ACH form for church contributions.
- 2) For Pre-K-6th grade, at St. James School you must turn in a **Catholic Baptismal certificate** to the school and the parents must donate 2 hours, 2 times a year in service to the St. James Elementary School.
- 3) The family must contribute **identifiably** to the support of the parish through the regular weekly or monthly use of the envelope system, by automatic draft/electronic fund transfer, your personal check to identify you or cash in an envelope with your name on it.
- 4) The family **must attend** weekend Mass with the parish family at St. James.
- 5) If you are an active supporting Catholic family from another parish, you may be eligible to receive subsidy through that parish. Contact the school principal for further information.

- Takes approximately 20-30 minutes to complete, followed by **The Gifts Discussion & Prayer** with the SGI Team (usually 15-20 minutes)



## The Gifts Discussion & Prayer

- The SGI Team will review your inventory with you
- Together, we help you discern your next steps if you choose to move forward in using your gifts
- We will pray together for courage, boldness, healing, discernment, encouragement and other gifts of the Holy Spirit
- We also explain that this is a first step in our Saint James Parish Intentional Discipleship journey

**The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night @ 7:24PM:** The entire celebration of the Easter Vigil must take place at night and is arranged in four parts: after a service of light and the Easter Proclamation (I), the church meditates on all the wonderful things God has done for his people from the beginning; this is the Liturgy of the Word (II). As the day of Resurrection approaches, new members of the Church are reborn in Baptism (III), and the whole Church is called to the table of the Lord prepared for his people through his Death and Resurrection; this is the Liturgy of the Eucharist (IV).
