

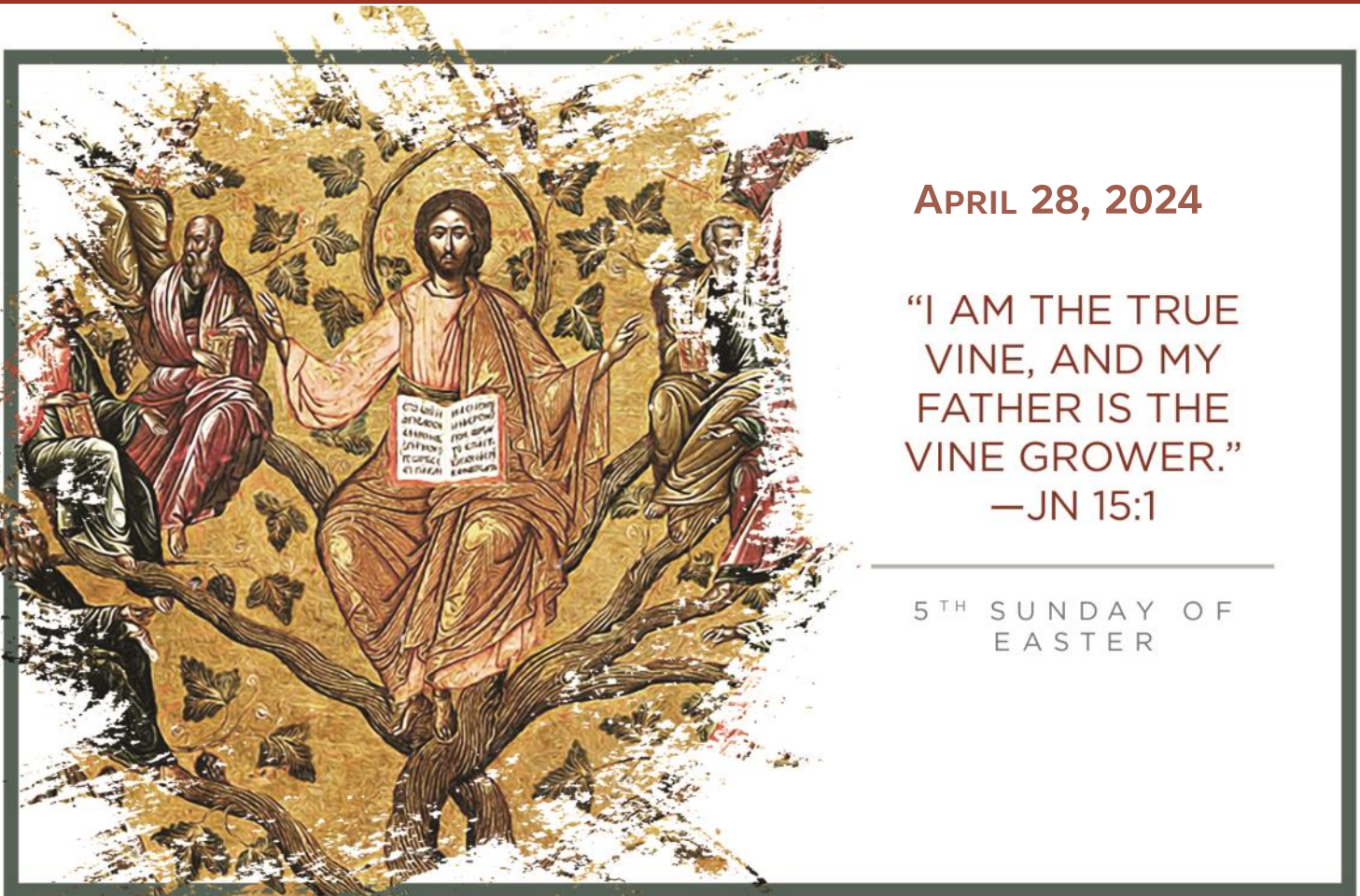

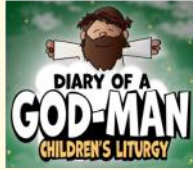

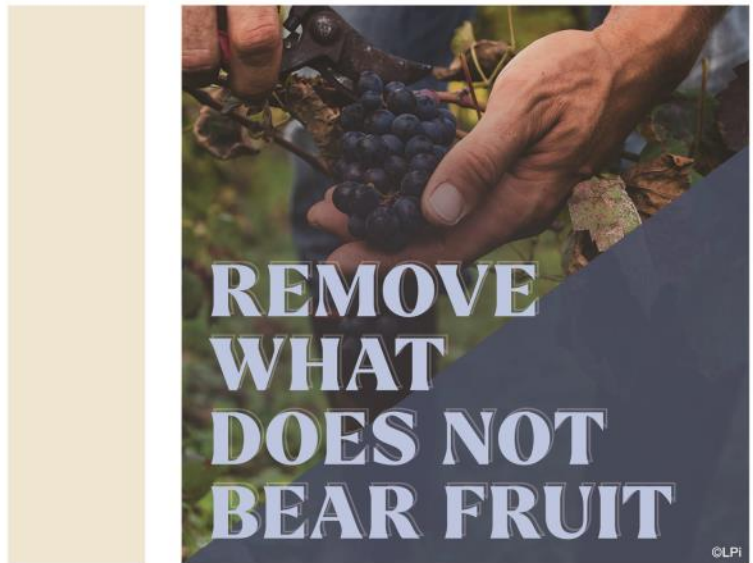

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

My friend and fellow pastor, Father Paul, noticed unsightly, overgrown trees near his parish church. He asked the maintenance crew to cut back the growth, which they happily did, telling him the trees would be much healthier and even fuller after a good pruning. A few days later, Father Paul received a letter from an irate man in the neighborhood who wrote, "Jesus would never prune trees like that. He loves trees, unlike you."

I suspect that the neighbor was not familiar with this week's Gospel in which Jesus says of his Father, "**He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit**" (John 15:2) I don't mean to pick too much on that fellow. He was perhaps ignorant of arboriculture. But I'd wager his main confusion was the pruning and removing quality of God's love. That confusion afflicts us all to some degree, doesn't it? It is just so darn easy to react negatively when God cuts something out of our lives and assume it's not his work at all. In the moment, all we see is the loss, and not the loving desire for future flourishing.

The cross is the great pruning of Christ's body. Jesus' rising is the brand-new growth. It is God's promise to us that all the painful pruning in life is leading us somewhere beautiful. What has been cut back or out in your life? A friend, an opportunity, a sense of certainty, a job, health, a relationship? This week, offer those dry branches to the one who lovingly prunes us in order to make our lives burst with verdant growth.

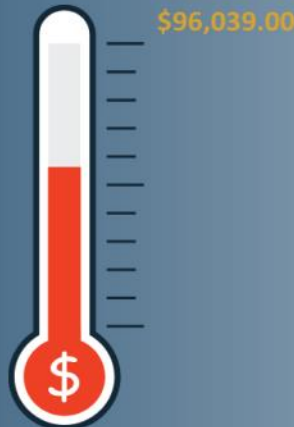

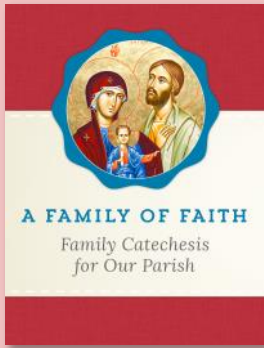


MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP

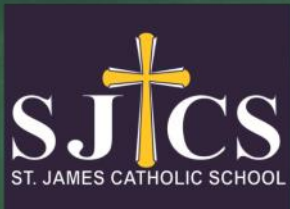

Eucharistic Miracle of DRONERO

In 1631, a young farm girl, foolishly kindled a fire with dry hay. Because of a heavy wind, the fire spread to the town of Dronero. Every attempt to extinguish the flames proved useless. A Capuchin friar, Maurice de Ceva, inspired by his great love of the Blessed Sacrament took the monstrance containing the large Host from the Church of St. Brigid and in procession walked to where the fire was raging. The fire at once subsided.



In the afternoon of Sunday August 3, 1631, a great fire broke out in the central district of Salame in the town of Dronero. A young farm girl foolishly kindled a fire with dry hay at the very moment an up wind was blowing into a thunderstorm. The flames quickly and violently spread to the home of the Signa Males. The semaphoric desperately attempted to extinguish the fire, but all their other proved useless as the fire dashed great flames. Four Master de Ceva, a Capuchin, was inspired in his own nature in the power of the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, he immediately organized a procession with the Blessed Sacrament - followed by all the congregation - to the location of the fire. The monstrance the Blessed Sacrament arrived, the flames subsided and miraculously were extinguished. The monstrance more is described in detail on a stone tablet in the small Church of St. Brigid. On the feast of Corpus Christi, the citizens of Dronero keep alive the memory of this miracle with a solemn annual procession with the Blessed Sacrament.

Eucharistic Miracle of SAN MAURO LA BRUCA

At San Mauro la Bruca unknown thieves secretly entered the church and stole several sacred objects - one was the pyx (ciborium) that contained consecrated Hosts. The thieves threw the Hosts aside; a child discovered them. The Hosts are preserved to this day.



On the night of July 25, 1968, some thieves broke into the parish church of San Mauro la Bruca with the intention of stealing some of the more precious objects. After they had pried open the tabernacle, they took a ciborium containing many consecrated Hosts. Once they left the church, the thieves accepted the ciborium and threw the Hosts on a bench. On the following morning, a child named the girl of Hosts at the intersection of the road and gathering there to be immediately give them to the pastor.
