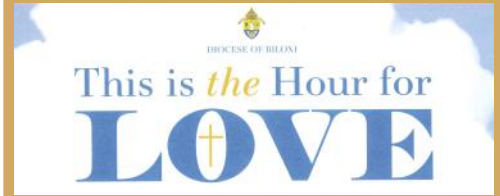

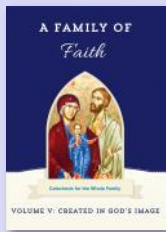

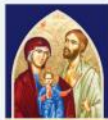

Baptism Preparation classes are held once a month. The next class will be on September 12.

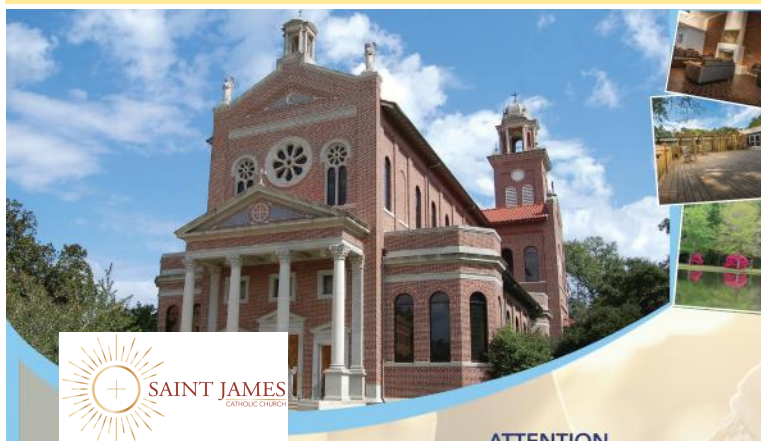

Clearing the Confusion: Common Misconceptions About Annulments

Many Catholics have questions regarding annulments. Here's the truth:

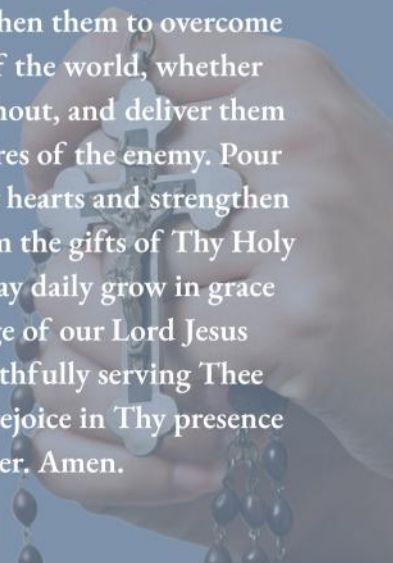
Myth: Only marriages that took place in the Catholic Church need an annulment before remarriage.

➔ **Truth:** The Church recognizes the marriages of all people—Catholic or not—as valid unless proven otherwise. This means that anyone who was previously married is not free to enter a new marriage in the Church until a declaration of nullity has been obtained. In some cases the process is straightforward and mostly administrative, but it is still necessary before a new marriage can be celebrated.
