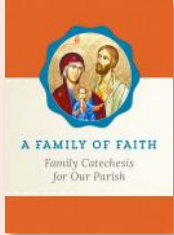

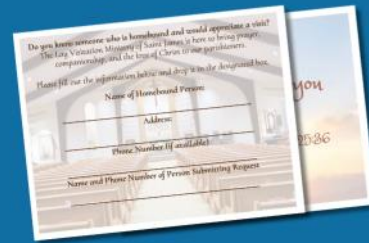

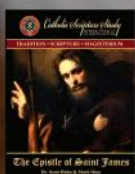

Clearing the Confusion: Common Misconceptions About Annulments

Many Catholics have questions regarding annulments. Here's the truth:

It's just "Catholic divorce."

➔ A civil divorce ends a marriage in the eyes of the state. An annulment (or declaration of nullity) is very different – it does not end a marriage, nor does it erase a relationship or family history. Instead, it examines the beginning of the marriage to determine whether the vows were valid according to the Church's understanding of marriage as a sacrament.

Civil divorce deals with legal matters; a declaration of nullity looks at the spiritual and sacramental reality. A couple may receive a civil divorce and still not be granted an annulment, and in some rare cases a marriage may be found invalid by the Church before a civil divorce.

So, an annulment is not "Catholic divorce," but a process of seeking truth and healing in light of the Gospel and Church teaching.
